

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

In 2020, donations drove nearly 85% of revenues, with fundraising events contributing the remaining 15%. Fundraising events were limited in 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Medical Clinic construction accounted for nearly 68% of operating expense in 2020, with Sick and Elderly Support and Orphan Scholarships at 10% and 8% respectively rounding out the top three expense categories. Administration expenses remained low at just 3% of total expense.
