- 2021** — **MEDICAL CLINIC 90% COMPLETE | SCHOOL PROJECT BREAKS GROUND**
Includes primary, elementary, and secondary school buildings
- 2020** — **PANDEMIC FOOD DRIVE**
Since access to food was affected, DMIWOO provided assistance and additional support
- 2019** — **WIDOW HOUSE RESTORATION**
Rehabilitated a dwelling for a widow and her children.
- 2018** — **BROKE GROUND ON MEDICAL CLINIC**
4 board members and 2 volunteers traveled to Obike for the clinic groundbreaking event
- 2017** — **LAUNCHED MEDICAL CLINIC PROJECT**
A dream becomes a reality with the 1st fundraising event for the clinic in September, 2017

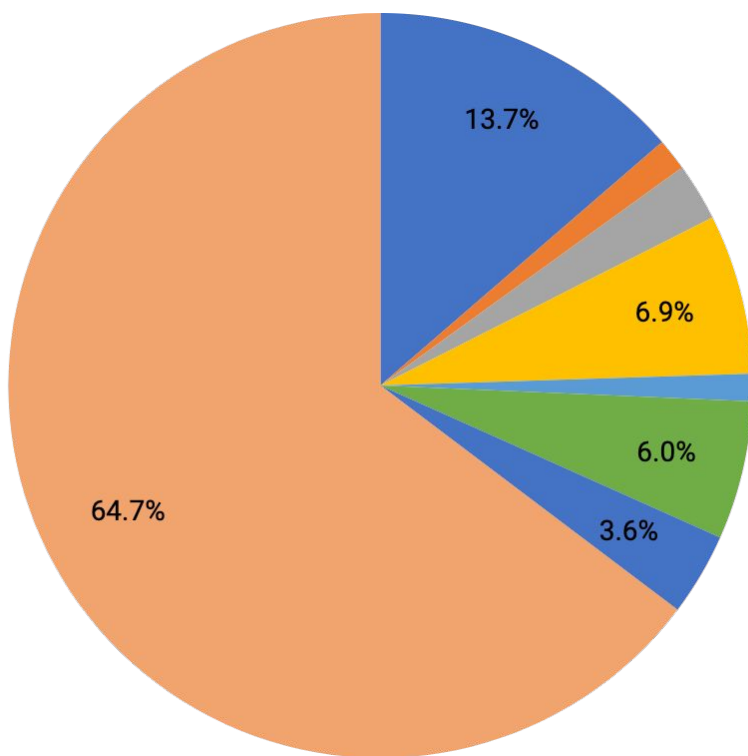

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

In 2021, donations drove 100% of revenues. Fundraising events were paused in 2021 due to the Covid-19 pandemic. School construction accounted for nearly 71% of operating expense in 2021, with Sick and Elderly Support and Orphan-related programs at 9% and 9% respectively rounding out the top three expense categories. Administration expenses remained low at just 3% of total expense.
